Each letter below corresponds to a total from the previous page. The letters with the 3 highest totals indicate the 3 areas where you are best suited to serve out of the options listed below.

- A. Administration:** If you scored high in this row, you are inclined toward the gift of Administration. Persons with the gift of administration lead by steering others to remain on task. Administration enables groups to organize according to God-given purposes and long term goals. Consider volunteering in the church office or with our Outreach ministry team.
