Introduction:

God does miracles. Whether we see them or not, whether we believe in them or not, miracles are occurring all around us. It is never too late to ask for a miracle and it is never to early to prepare for a miracle.

Scripture:

Luke 1:6-7 — "Zechariah and Elizabeth were righteous in God's eyes, careful to obey all of the Lord's commandments and regulations. They had no children because Elizabeth was unable to conceive, and they were both very old."

Luke 1:11-13 — "While Zechariah was in the sanctuary, an angel of the Lord appeared to him, standing to the right of the incense altar. Zechariah was shaken and overwhelmed with fear when he saw him. But the angel said, "Don't be afraid, Zechariah! God has heard your prayer. Your wife, Elizabeth, will give you a son, and you are to name him John."
