PSALM 66

¹Shout joyful praises to God, all the earth! ²Sing about the glory of his name! Tell the world how glorious he is. ³ Say to God, "How awesome are your deeds! Your enemies cringe before your mighty power. ⁴ Everything on earth will worship you; they will sing your praises, shouting your name in glorious songs."

PSALM 67

¹ May God be merciful and bless us. May his face smile with favor on us. ² May your ways be known throughout the earth, your saving power among people everywhere. ³ May the nations praise you, O God. Yes, may all the nations praise you. ⁴ Let the whole world sing for joy, because you govern the nations with justice and guide the people of the whole world.

PSALM 102

¹⁸ Let this be recorded for future generations, so that a people not yet born will praise the Lord. ¹⁹ Tell them the Lord looked down from his heavenly sanctuary. He looked down to earth from heaven ²⁰ to hear the groans of the prisoners, to release those condemned to die.

1 TIMOTHY 2

¹I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. ² Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. ³ This is good and pleases God our Savior, ⁴ who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.

¹¹ Teach me your ways, O Lord, that I may live according to your truth! Grant me purity of heart, so that I may honor you. ¹² With all my heart I will praise you, O Lord my God. I will give glory to your name forever,

¹³ for your love for me is very great. You have rescued me from the depths of death.

LUKE 10
