## PSALM 66

<sup>1</sup>Shout joyful praises to God, all the earth!  
<sup>2</sup>Sing about the glory of his name! Tell the world how glorious he is. <sup>3</sup>Say to God, "How awesome are your deeds! Your enemies cringe before your mighty power. <sup>4</sup>Everything on earth will worship you; they will sing your praises, shouting your name in glorious songs."

## PSALM 67

<sup>1</sup> May God be merciful and bless us. May his face smile with favor on us. <sup>2</sup> May your ways be known throughout the earth, your saving power among people everywhere. <sup>3</sup> May the nations praise you, O God. Yes, may all the nations praise you. <sup>4</sup> Let the whole world sing for joy, because you govern the nations with justice and guide the people of the whole world.

## PSALM 102

<sup>18</sup> Let this be recorded for future generations, so that a people not yet born will praise the Lord. <sup>19</sup> Tell them the Lord looked down from his heavenly sanctuary. He looked down to earth from heaven <sup>20</sup> to hear the groans of the prisoners, to release those condemned to die.

## 1 TIMOTHY 2

<sup>1</sup>I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. <sup>2</sup> Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. <sup>3</sup> This is good and pleases God our Savior, <sup>4</sup> who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.

## PSALM 86

<sup>11</sup> Teach me your ways, O Lord, that I may live according to your truth! Grant me purity of heart, so that I may honor you. <sup>12</sup> With all my heart I will praise you, O Lord my God. I will give glory to your name forever,  
<sup>13</sup> for your love for me is very great. You have rescued me from the depths of death.

## LUKE 10

<sup>1</sup> These were his instructions to them: "The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields.
