Scripture:

Psalms 66:1-5 — v 5 “Come and see what God has done, his awesome deeds for mankind!”

John 1:43-50 — v 46 “Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?” Nathanael asked.
'Come and see,' said Philip.”

Matthew 28:1-7 — v 6 “He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay.”

Discussion Questions:

1. Share a significant move or change and the impact it had on your life.
2. The three scripture verses above all are inviting someone to “come and see,” discuss how these scriptures apply to your life today.
3. How has Jesus already impacted your life? What is Jesus currently doing or inviting you to do and how is this requiring you to move?
4. How do you feel about the belief that God has something better in store for you, but this requires you to move?
5. Does remembering how Jesus has already impacted your life give you hope? Does remembering how God has been faithful allow you to trust him more?

Take the Next Step:

Pray for God to lead you faithfully and to allow you to fully trust him as he moves you toward his promise land. What is the actual next step you need to take to move in the direction God is leading you? Take that step.
