

Introduction:

Scripture:

Hosea 14:1 - "Return, O Israel, to the Lord your God, for your sins have brought you down."

Hosea 14:4 - "The Lord says, "Then I will heal you of your faithlessness; my love will know no bounds, for my anger will be gone forever."

Colossians 2:13 - "You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for he forgave all our sins."
